Perhaps the most surprising thing is that TJ no longer worked at NASA... but had become Santa Claus. (What the hell is going on here?) And finally, something called "the Internet" had transformed the planet (and apparently the McCarty Party invitation).

So a lot has transpired since 1985. The beer consumed at the party grew steadily until its pinnacle in 1996 – *Ale University* (40 kegs ordered; 33 consumed), but the quality of the

invitations (with the exception of 2006's <u>McCardi Code</u>) had plummeted. We did however appreciate 2008's <u>Pub Scouts of America</u> adding the Underwear Underground to the traditional list of McCarty Party activities.

Martinis (used in our logos for years) are finally served, as the thought of "Martians and Martinis" always makes us laugh (kind of like Bugs Bunny in a dress or Billy Baker in a nunnery, or vice versa).

The last one we'll mention is 2125 – <u>Glip Snort</u> (as we've always said, trust us... it will make sense at the time). At this party, through the teachings of the Brothers McCarty, universal peace is established. Also, we finally entered the Matrix (and it only took us 143 McCarty Parties and about 1,100 liver transplants to get there). Man, were we tired (and drunk).

In Conclusion

Well that's enough of a glimpse forward. We certainly don't want to upset the space-time continuum (unless it involves Heather Locklear). So it's back to 1985 for us. Back to the safety of the Reagan presidency and Goebel's beer. Wish us luck. It will be Deja vu, all over again.
