Twelve Things You Need to Know about McCarty Party 2020, before you get here

1) Swimming Pool: So... we have a small swimming with a large deck around it (and thanks to all those that helped us make that a reality). However, as we learned during McCarty Party Two (on the farm, with a pond and some inner tubes), water and the McCarty Party don't mix well (kind of like the Kardashians and professional athletes).
