#### PROTEST RALLY PLANNED

### Local BBT(N) Chapter to Hold Protest at '96 Commencement

An Ale University student organization has announced plans for a protest rally at this summer’s commencement ceremony. Eliza Zee Ryder, president of the local chapter of Blondes for a Better Tomorrow (Night), said that a rally protesting the distribution of condoms in the sponsor packs given to alumni contributors is planned. Miss Ryder (known on campus as E.Z.) went on to explain the basis of BBT(N)’s protest.
